Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. ~ Philippians 4:6



Council Highlights

To express God's love and grace in building a community where people **believe** in God, **belong** to Christ, and **become** disciples who serve in day-to-day living.

Devotions: Council members discussed the third and fourth chapters of "Holy Disruption: A Manifesto for the Future of Faith Communities." The 2025 book calls on congregations to reimagine their Christian community. Themes discussed included how to use a church building differently, a congregation's understanding of God is tied to how it "does" church, the struggle between routine and change, and ways to connect to the community. Chapters five and six will be discussed in November.

Pastor: Two youth, Reed Sommers, and Jackson Triplett, were confirmed Oct. 5. Pastor attended a 48-hour silent retreat at Pacem in Terris Hermitage Retreat Center near Isanti, Minnesota, in early October. He would like to take a group there in 2026, after leading a conversation on the Christian mystics. Stewardship Sunday with æbleskiver during Fellowship Hour will be Nov. 23. He is leading a book discussion on "The God Who Sees," which looks at Biblical stories through the lens of immigration.

Council President: Kleppe said training begins next week for new offering counters Brad Anderson and Janet Topp. Kleppe, Kopack and Paulson have agreed to serve second two-year Council terms. The Nominating Committee will need to fill Council slots being vacated next year by Eaves (stepping down after one term) and Hendee (term-limited). The Buy Nothing Bazaar was wildly successful and will likely be repeated. The Personnel Committee will meet with Patricia McKee, Christian Life Coordinator, for her scheduled six-month review.

Treasurer: Link presented the September financial report. Year-to-date giving at the end of September was \$26,100 under budget, but coming into the highest giving period. Expenditures for the same period were \$26,800 under budget. The Change 4 Change program (all Sunday offerings of loose coins and bills not linked to a member's offering envelope number) raised \$125 in September. The September contributions went to ELCA Disaster Relief in the aftermath of Texas flooding. Change 4 Change funds in October and November will be sent to The Key youth center.

New Business 1: Jesse Pick, committee chair of Cub Scout Pack 300, presented a request for St. Peter's to host the group. The pack has about 35 members in grades K-5. St. Peter's member Brian Kopack is a pack leader. After discussion, the Council unanimously approved a motion by Hanson, second by Link, for St. Peter's to host the pack.

New Business 2: Kleppe presented the Council with Paulson's compilation of how attendees at the "Conversation With the Council" event prioritized potential maintenance and renovation projects inside and outside the church during the Sept. 21 Fellowship Hour. Replacing the office wing's air conditioner and furnace ranked No. 1. The Stewardship Committee's Fruity French Toast fundraising meal served during the Oct. 12 Fellowship Hour raised more than \$500 for the HVAC project.

Discussion on the Council's vision for St. Peter's in the coming decade remained tabled.
